

## Northeast Community Propel Academy School Cell Phone Policy, Grades 6 thru 8

Dear NE Community Propel Academy families,

We at Propel are contemporary educators who are well aware of the way of the world and the necessity of modern technology. We are also committed educators who are determined to make our school as safe, supportive, and bully-free as possible. It is because of this that we will be enforcing a "bell-to-bell" no cell phone policy. Students in grades six, seven, and eight each have an individual locker to place their cell phone in. There will be no class assignments where students need to use their cell phone and the main office is available if you at home need to contact the student.

If a student is seen with a cell phone out during the school day (including lunch/recess) that will be considered a violation of this policy. Below are the list of consequences for each violation:

- 1) Guardian notified; Phone confiscated and returned at end of day
- 2) Guardian notified; 8am detention; Phone confiscated and returned at end of day.
- 3) Guardian notified; 8am detention; Phone turned into administration and picked up by guardian at end of day; student assigned Saturday detention.
